We are still operating our food distribution for those in need with most weeks having bread and bakery items, fresh fruit and vegetables.

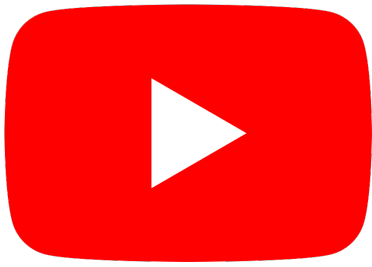
If you normally or would like to donate non-perishable items that would be greatly appreciated. Items can be dropped off on a Wednesday morning between 9-10am.
